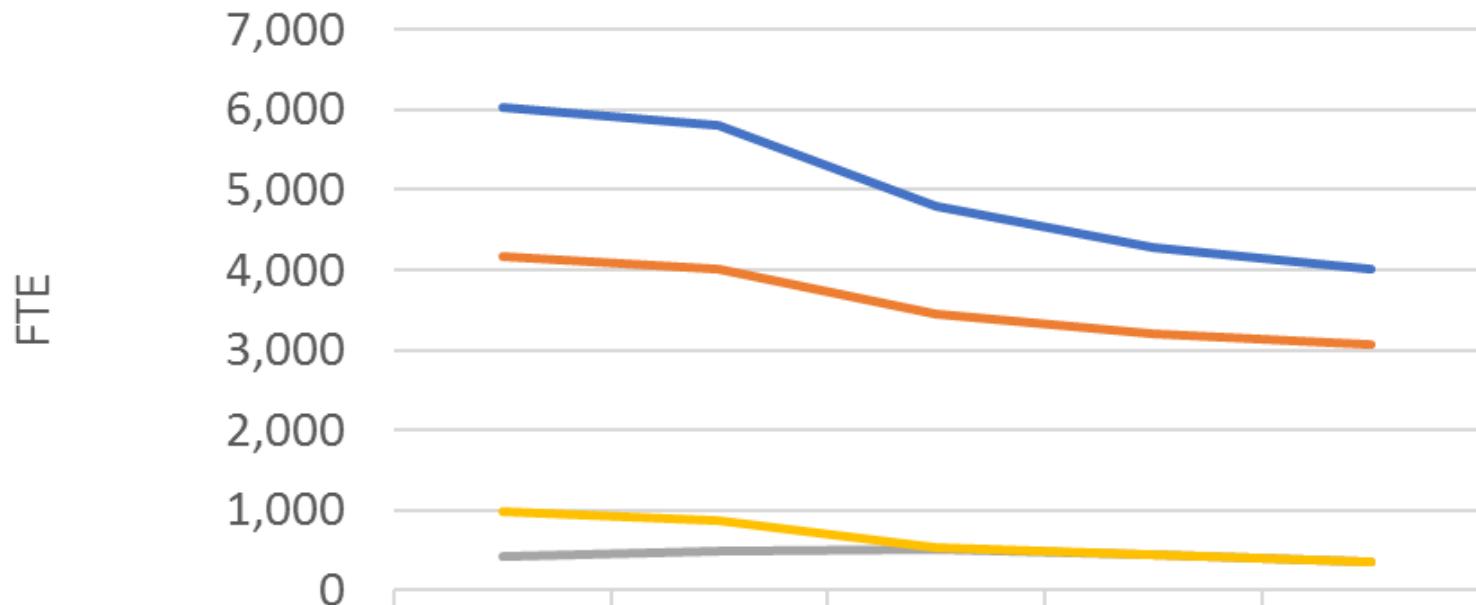
## Enrollment (FTEs)
